

ICT ASSISTANT.

Job Purpose:

The IT Assistant will support the College's ICT services, assist in the management of online learning platforms, and collaborate with the Marketing Unit to strengthen the institution's digital visibility. The role ensures smooth IT operations, reliable e-learning delivery, and effective use of social media for brand presence.

Duties and Responsibilities:

a) ICT Support Services

- Provide first-line IT support to staff and students, including troubleshooting hardware, software, and network issues.
- Maintain ICT equipment, including computers, printers, projectors, and internet connectivity.
- Support implementation and maintenance of college ICT systems, including user account management and data backups.
- Assist in cybersecurity awareness and compliance within the College.

b) Online Studies Management
